

**Covered and Single Lane Bridge Cruise
Hunterdon County NJ
Wednesday Nite September 1st Stewart's Cruise**

Taillights at 6:30 pm

Note - this is a scenic cruise - speeds will be slow as most roads are not two lanes wide and visibility is limited - enjoy the scenery.

**Starting point Stewart's Root Beer Stand Rt 202/31 South of Flemington
(Southbound lane.)**

1. Exit through the back of Stewarts lot and turn left - go up a short distance and take the first right onto Hampton Corner Rd
2. Proceed on Hampton Corner Rd until you come to a stop at the T. Turn left onto Rt 579
3. Continue South on Rt 579, passing Everetts Rd, on your left, and Yard Rd, on your right. Immediately after crossing a small brook - turn right onto Dunkard Church Rd (very narrow - 25 mph)
4. Continue on Dunkard Church Rd until you come to the stop at the T intersection with Sandbrook-Headquarters Rd. Turn right and then take a quick left onto Lambert Rd. Continue on Lambert Rd and it will join Rt 604 at a stop (a Y-intersection) going into Sergeantsville.
5. Proceed on Rt 604 West into Segeantsville and go straight across at the Red Blinker in the center of town. (we will have trouble getting through this intersection - the lead car will pull off to the right just up the road for re-grouping.)
6. Continue on Rt 604 West, going slowly through the Green Sergeant Bridge (the last historic covered bridge in NJ)
7. Immediately on exiting the bridge, turn right onto Upper Creek Rd - caution, very narrow! Go about 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ miles then turn left onto Featherbed Rd
8. Continue on Featherbed Rd for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile then turn right onto Hammer Rd
9. Stay on Hammer Rd for 1.1 miles then make a sharp left onto Kingwood Locktown Rd.
10. Stay on Kingwood Locktown Rd. for 1.1 miles then turn right on Muddy Run Rd - Continue to the stop at the T
11. Turn right onto Barbertown-Point Breeze Rd and continue for 0.7 miles
12. Turn left onto Union Rd - continue for 1.9 miles to the stop at the T
13. Make a right onto Rt 519 - and continue Northbound to the 1st traffic light.
14. Go right at the light onto Rt 12 East - the Canyon Creek Restaurant is on your left just past the State Police Barracks. The front portion of the lot is paved - the sides and rear are not.

Should take about 40 minutes
